No. 18011/3/80-Estt.(Leave) dated 3rd September, 1981 and Notification No. 18011/3/80-Estt.(L) dated 28/7/1984, the facility of half pay leave will be restored to Teachers, Principals, Headmasters, Librarians, Laboratory Assistants and Watermen working in schools under the Central Government, at par with other Central Government employees under the provisions of Rule 29 of the Central Civil Services (Leave) Rules, 1972.

2. These orders shall take effect from 1st September, 2008.
