CIRCULAR

This Directorate had issued circular vide No.F.38(11)/P&PF/Anomaly/2008/178-90 dated 03.06.2010 regarding grant of benefit of bunching to Assistant Teachers, whose pay scale has been upgraded and placed in PB-2 (Rs. 9300-34800) with Grade Pay of Rs. 4200/- as per the clarification issued by the Ministry of HRD. Ministry of HRD suggested to deal these cases as per 7(A)(ii) of CS(RP) Rules 2008.

It has been brought to the notice of undersigned that HOS are not implementing the said circular even after the matter had already been clarified by the Ministry of HRD and forwarded to all concerned for implementation.

Now all the HOS are again advised to deal the case of Primary /Assistant Teachers for the grant of bunching as per rule 7(A)(ii) of CS(RP)Rules, 2008 and settle their cases at the earliest.

Sub: Anomaly in pay fixation as per CCS (RP) Rules, 2008.

Sir,

I am directed to refer your letter No. 38(11)/P&PF/Anomaly/2008/963 dated 04.3.2010 on the subject mentioned above. The part-wise clarification to the issues raised vide your letter under reference are as under: -

Sl. No.	Points raised	Comments
1.	Teachers appointed prior to 1.1.2006 are getting less pay than those appointed after 1.1.2006 for example; post of TGT in 5500-9000 has been upgraded to scale of Rs. 7450-11500. Pay of a TGT appointed in 2005 with basis pay of Rs. 5500/- on 1.1.2006 is fixed as Rs. 14830/- (5500X 1.86+4600 GP) whereas for new recruit it is Rs. 17140/- (12540+4600)	Cases may be settled in accordance with the clarification given by D/o Expenditure (Implementation Cell) vide their IC UO No. 10/1/2008 IC dated 27.2.2009.(copy enclosed)
2.	Pay of Principals recruited through promotion from feeder post is fixed under Rule 13 of CCS (RP) Rules 2008 (under FR 22(I) a (I). However, pay of Principals recruited through UPSC is fixed at entry level as per Section II (Part A) of first Schedule of CCS (RP) Rules, 2008. Whether the post of Principals where some teaching experience is essential, is to be treated as direct recruits and whether the benefit of entry-level pay with GP of Rs. 7600 is applicable in this case?	Query raised does not indicate the specific point on which clarification is required. The same may be elaborated.


